



# Quick Start Guide: Leapster<sup>®</sup>2 Connected Learning Game System

The Leapster<sup>®</sup>2 connects to your computer to upload your child's play data to their personal LeapFrog Learning Path. LeapFrog's Learning Path is a free online tool that lets you see your child's learning progress with their Connected games.



## 1. Set up the Leapster2

- Insert batteries, then turn on the Leapster2
- Select your country (required the first time only)
- When prompted, create (or ask your child to create) a player profile
- Create a player profile for each child that will play with the Leapster2 (up to 3 can be stored)



## 2. Set up your computer

- Insert the LeapFrog Connect CD (included in the box) into your computer
- If you can't locate the CD, [download the software](#) from LeapFrog.com
- Follow the prompts to install the LeapFrog Connect application
- LeapFrog Connect will prompt you to connect the Leapster2 to your computer



## 3. Connect the Leapster2 to your computer

- Open the LeapFrog Connect application if it isn't already open on your computer
- Turn off the Leapster2 (it must be turned off before connecting it to your computer)
- Connect the Leapster2 to your computer using the USB cable included in the box
- Turn on the Leapster2
- Follow the prompts on your **computer screen** to complete the set up by creating a LeapFrog Parent account (or signing in to your existing account), creating a [footprint](#) for each child that will play with the Leapster2 and linking player profiles created on the Leapster2 with the child footprints you created
- You have now created a personal [Learning Path](#) for each child that will play with the Leapster2



## 4. Play!

- Have your child select their player profile each time they play with their Leapster2 and connect the Leapster2 to your computer often to upload your child's [play data](#)
